The 100 Club has always been a very good method of raising funds. The club is open to parents of current pupils and staff members of Maidstone Grammar School and any parents of former pupils, who joined the club while their children attended the school. This letter explains how the 100 Club operates, please keep for future reference. The club rules are attached.

How much does it cost? Each number costs £30 per year. There is no start or finish date to the scheme, so you can join at any time.

How do I pay? Payment is by cheque or Parentmail, of £30.

How does it work? There will be a monthly draw for one prize of £50, with a bonus draw of £1000 in December. However, the committee shall have absolute discretion to reduce the amount payable in prizes should membership drop to an unacceptable level.

All prize winners are notified in writing and a list of winners is posted on the school website.

What do I do now? New numbers are now available, and we would like to invite you to join the 100 Club, but remember that membership is limited, so fill out your application soon to avoid disappointment. You can choose to increase your chances by purchasing more than one monthly share. Should you wish to join, please complete the Membership application form and send it in to MGSPA, via the school office.
